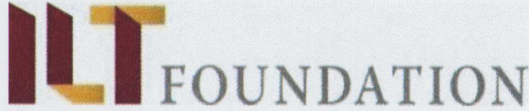




**INVERCARGILL ROWING CLUB SPRINTS REGATTA

REGATTA CONDITIONS

Racing will be one day straight finals. The qualifying date for all age group events is **31st of December 2024** ie athletes must be under the age on that date.

All events are over a 800 metre course - Final 3 races are 500 metres

Master's fours/quads may be coxed or coxless handicaps will apply

Masters points.

- **SRA are trialing a new Masters Points system 12 -8 -4 for the 2024/25 season these points will not be combined with age and club aggregate points**
- **With the number of combined club crews - points will be awarded to the rowers club —Refer attachment**
- **Bluff - Sprints - Legion - Southland Championships and Masters & junior regatta will be regattas for Masters points**
- **Masters races will be handicapped using the Australian handicap system and be displayed on the day sheet- Handicapped at the start line**
- **Entries must be received with appropriate age group and Club affiliation attached - no age group no entry - crews without an age group will be allowed to compete- however no points will be awarded**
- **No points for crews that include school/open class rowers that may have been bought in to fill a crew**
- **Masters Crews that also compete in open/ club/intermediate class can only receive points in one class**

All events shall be rowed under the rules of the S.R.A and N.Z.R.A. All events which are sanctioned by the Southland Rowing Association are to be run in accordance with the Rowing New Zealand Rules of Racing 2022

All requests from the Chief Umpire with regards to the safety of participants must be adhered to.

The Chief Umpire reserves the right to postpone, delay or cancel the regatta at any time if concerns for the safety of any regatta participant exist.

All coxswains must wear lifejackets.

Any events with more than seven starters may be rowed in divisions.

Alpha Numeric Lane numbers must be used -supplied by the SRA

Lane number one is closest to the starter. All events start strictly at the advertised time.

Crews should be within the starting area a minimum of five (5) minutes before the advertised start time.

All scratching's must be given to the regatta secretary no later than 30 minutes before the advertised start time of the event.

CREW CHANGES - Clubs not notifying crew changes- all classes- prior to race start -- points may not be awarded to that crew

A representative from all clubs participating are to attend a meeting at 8.15am at the IRC Clubrooms

Crews must proceed to the start inside lane one, on the clubroom side of the course.

Any crew missing the start must row down the far side of the course.

Clubs must ensure skiffs are in a safe condition and must make them available to an umpire for inspection if required. Any skiff deemed unsafe by the umpire may not be used until the fault has been rectified and the skiff has been passed as safe by the umpire.

Crews are reminded that at the finish, all skiffs must remain parallel to the course until the race umpire has cleared the race.

EXCLUSION OF TORT LIABILITY OF WHATEVER KIND

The Southland Rowing Association reminds rowing clubs and rowers participating in the Invercargill Rowing Club Sprints regatta that while every care will be taken by the regatta officials to ensure that the regatta is conducted safely and efficiently and in accordance with the Rules of Racing established by The New Zealand Rowing Association Inc. and/or amended by The Southland Rowing Association Inc., it is the responsibility of clubs to ensure that those rules are complied with and of rowers to comply with them to ensure safe rowing activity.

Further, it is a condition of participating in this regatta that all participants accept and note that no liability either in tort or of any other nature whatsoever is accepted by or will be attached to The New Zealand Rowing Association Inc. or The Southland Rowing Association Inc. for any harm, damage, loss, costs, expenses, inconvenience, interference of whatever nature and whatever kind including any damage to equipment or injury to persons of whatever nature incurred in the course of or in connection with or in any way related to the regatta regardless of whether any error or omission, wrong doing, negligence or other tort.

Age is as of 31st of December 2024

The age category of a master's crew is calculated by the average age of the crew. Proof of age required if requested. (e.g., Drivers Licence).

- A. Minimum age 27 years or more
- B. Average age 36 years or more
- C. Average age 43 years or more
- D. Average age 50 years or more
- E. Average age 55 years or more
- F. Average age 60 years or more
- G. Average age 65 years or more
- H. Average age 70 years or more
- I. Average age 75 years or more
- J. Average age 80 years or more
